### **Acronis OS Selector 5.0 Deluxe**

"...What the Acronis OS Selector 5.0 Deluxe (now included into Acronis Disk Director Suite 9.0) allows experienced computer users to do is install multiple operating systems such as Windows and Linux on the same hard drive, and then control the boot-up process so the PC can be started with any installed OS. It can create separate partitions on the hard disk, supporting multiple file types including FAT16, FAT32, NTFS, Ext2 and ReiserFS, and even convert between FAT16 and FAT32 / FAT files (File Allocation Table) keep your hard disk in order, and keep a record of which bits of the disk are used, unless or faulty. Once you've created partitions on the disk they can be resized, copied, hidden, moved and converted between primary and extended/logical. Even disk cluster sizes can be altered, and software includes full support for every large drives, over 64 Gb. it supports all current PC operating systems, including the latest Red Hat Linux Ext3 file system..."
