
PeerSync PSObserver, Version 3.0.2

To upgrade, double-click on the installation file (obs20.exe) in the Explorer window, or choose "Run" from the Start Menu and then select the application.

If you are upgrading the current version of PSObserver (2.0.2 to 3.0.2) simply install the application over your existing PSObserver and the previous version will be backed up in a sub-folder called 'BACKUP' (if the option to keep a backup is selected during the installation).

If you are evaluating a new version of Observer 3.0 and you already have an existing copy of Observer 2.0 or older, please select a new directory during the installation.

1448	<p>NEW! Added a new Profile Editor menu option (Help > Enable All Optional Features) which lets you enable all Profile features, including those that are not licensed. This allows for the ability to create and edit Profiles without license restrictions. This functionality is beneficial in a multi-license environment, where the Profile Editor is used to create/edit Profiles that require different licenses. 1449	When hosting the Profile Editor on a server it will allow the loading of a Profile that is licensed with a Workstation key. The Profile Editor now simply checks that a valid license is being used and allow Workstation configurations to be viewed/edited on a server.
