

Goal: To create/touch a specified trigger file with the purpose of enabling further action. (Example to kick off the next level synchronization, such as in a multi-tier synchronization process)

This would be a useful feature if you are synchronizing Multiple Machines and each machine is dependent on the completion of another. The UPDATETRIGGERFILE command would be used on the primary Profile and the Trigger Selections together with the global argument /PTE will be used on the secondary Profiles. (Refer to the Multi-Tiered Replication document for more information)

This argument is included in the Pre/Post Process window.

Use the following Format to setup the **UPDATETRIGGERFILE** in the **BEFORE or AFTER** field of the **Pre/Post Process section**.

UPDATETRIGGERFILE "file path"

Examples:

```
UPDATETRIGGERFILE "%TARGETPATH%\GLBLCHG.000";
```

The %TARGETPATH% variable takes the full Target directory path.
